## Rome, 16-17 September 2010

The conference seeks to bring together first-rate current research on "Transparency, Disclosure and Market Discipline in Banking Regulation" building on the experience of the recent crisis.

Up to twelve papers will be selected and suitable topics may include, but are not limited to:

- a. Mark to market accounting
- b. Opacity of banks' assets
- c. The role of credit rating agencies
- d. Corporate governance, risk taking and disclosure
- e. Disclosure regulation
- f. Market discipline and its role during the banking crisis

Researchers wishing to submit papers for consideration should submit them by **June 1st**, **2010**
